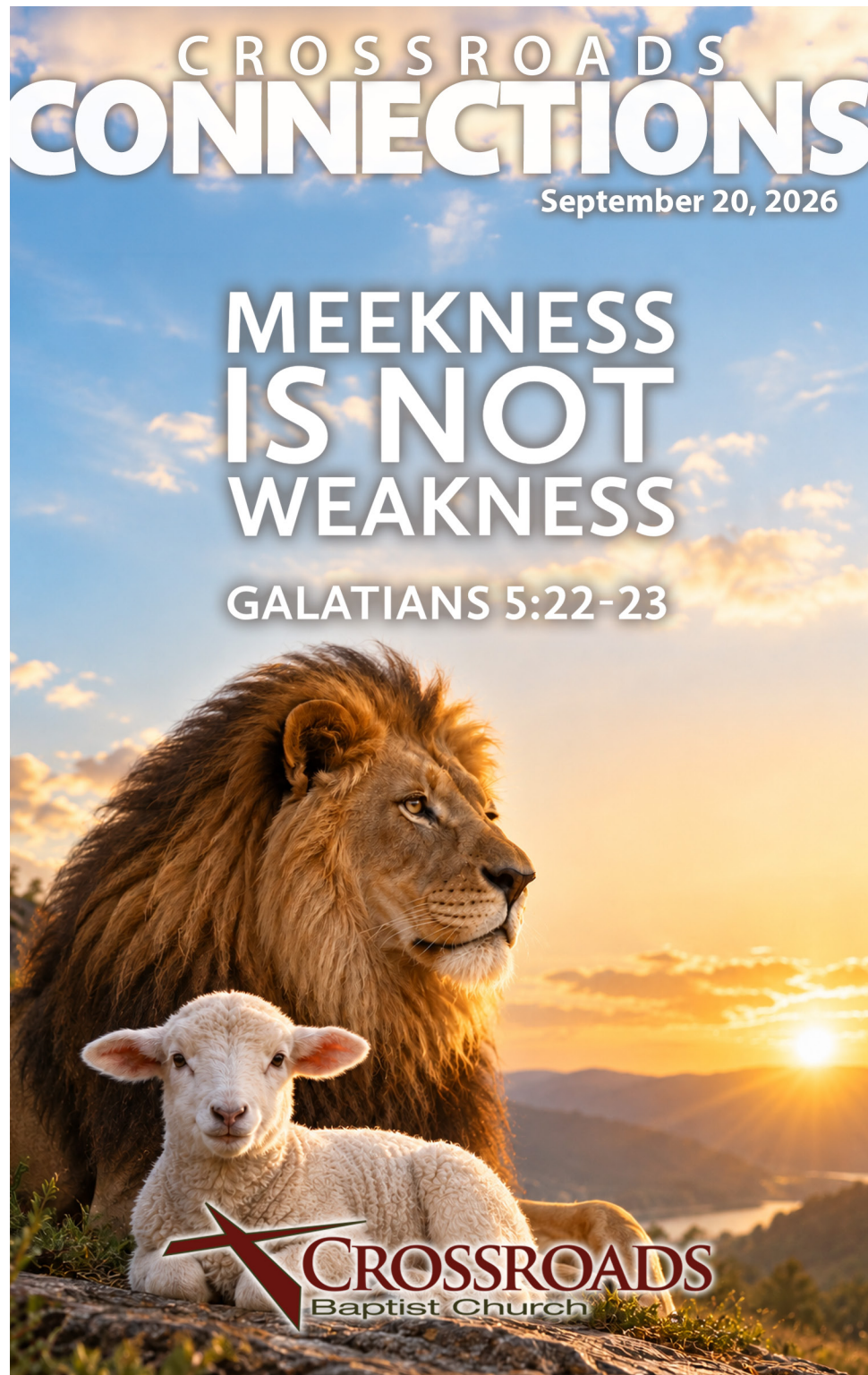
Quarterly Family Conference
